

Tandia - promote health and education in Tanzania e.V.

Tandia stands for 'Tanzania Kusaidia' (Kusaidia = Help). We are a nonprofit organisation that has no commercial background and neither religious, political or other ideological goals. We are only committed to humanitarian values and want to contribute to improve health care and school education in Tanzania.

Regina Meissner from the Hessian Langoens, a small community near Giessen has initiated the nonprofit organisation. She is a nurse by training, nurse teacher and health scientist and has worked as development advisor in Tanzania until 2015. After many years of work experience and involvement in development aid in different countries she believes that small organizations can work more efficiently and thus support arrives faster.



Health is not everything, but without health everything is nothing

For many people in Tanzania a necessary health care is inaccessible and unaffordable. Missing or costly drugs, dilapidated facilities and poorly trained health workers are the main causes of the shortage.

The maternal and infant mortality is still alarmingly high, which, according to World Health Organization, is mainly due to the inadequate care. Malaria, for many children under five is still a frequent cause of preventable death.

Up to 80% of medical expenses, people pay out of pocket. They thus carry a high risk due to the cost of treatment to deplete.



40-80 patients are treated at the small health facility on a daily basis.

The health project - what we do!

Tandia is active in Northern Tanzania and supports the expansion of a (the only) health facility for about 4500 villagers. We provide financial support for construction, medical equipment and medicines and thus establish the precondition for improved quality medical care for patients, especially for pregnant women, mothers and children.

Many problems and the often difficult conditions on the ground, we know very well from own work experience. Therefore, we are visiting the project to accompany and supervise the implementation of project activities on site.

Thanks to the excellent cooperation with the district medical director and the doctor of the health station, our activities can be implemented efficiently. We also can rely on the support by the dispensary health committee and villagers.



Education is the key for an independent life in dignity

What is taken for granted in high income countries, namely a good and cost-fair school education, remains a dream for most people in Tanzania.

While private, better quality schools are far too expensive, public schools lack classrooms, teachers and teaching materials.



In this primary school 900 children are taught in few dilapidated classrooms by 16 teachers. Up to 100 students in one classroom is a normal state. Drinking water must be brought from home, because at school there is no running water.

The school project - what we do!

For teachers support we organize volunteering of qualified teacher students from Germany.

Together with the community we are working on a sustainable and secure supply of drinking water for school and health facility.
